- ✓ Coverage up to DKK 30,000 per year


#### Your insurance does not cover

- X Cosmetic treatments
- × Orthodontics
- ➤ Root-treated teeth are covered by basic coverage, i.e. covered for everything other than prosthetics
- ➤ Teeth with 3 or more fillings are covered by basic coverage
- X Missing teeth at the time of application and baby teeth
- We cover any problems that may exist from day one, but not ongoing, planned or diagnosed treatments (only applies to prosthetics)

<sup>\*)</sup> This scheme covers approximately 95% of all dental treatments we may encounter.\*\*) Dental accidents and chewing injuries are included in the scheme.
